Question & Answers

Q: Who inspects the neighborhood for violations?

A: The management company inspector drives through the neighborhood twice a month to log violations. On one of these inspections each month, an officer of the association accompanies the inspector.

Q: Who is responsible for maintaining the landscaping around the pond?

A: The HOA common areas include the walkway to the pond, the dam at the South end of the pond as well as 25 feet along the waterline on the East side of the pond. HOA is only responsible for maintaining the landscaping of the dam. The CCRs require that the homeowners on the East side of the pond maintain the landscaping down to the waterline. The North and West sides of the pond are privately owned to the waterline and are the responsibility of the respective homeowners.

When taking your furry pets on a walk anywhere inside the North Fort community, including the pond area, remember that our furry friends do not clean up after themselves. Our pets *rely* on us to do that for them. Our neighbors *expect* it. No one can enjoy playing, fishing, walking, or jogging in an area where there's a big steamy pile of (you know).

For the safety of the motorists and those in the area, there are no motorized vehicles (such as motor bikes or ATVs) allowed on the walking path to the pond. For further pond rules and regulations, please visit the website under the Pond tab.

It's a violation for anyone to operate an unlicensed, unregistered electric or combustion engine recreational vehicles of any kind.
