A: Contact Clayton Animal Control Officer, Kostka Patrick (919) 553-4611 or Johnston County Animal Services (919) 934-8474.

Q: How do you report pot holes and road damage within the community?

A: Provide crossing street names, and contact NCDOT (877) 368-4968 or report online at www.ncdot.gov.

Q: Can HOA dues be paid online?

A: Per Treasurer Jones, this capability is currently being pursued and should be available shortly.

Q: What types of fish do we have in the Community pond?

A: There are Bass, Crappies, Bream, and Catfish.

When visiting the pond area, please be mindful to pickup after yourselves. This includes making sure your furry companions don't leave any unpleasant mementos behind.
